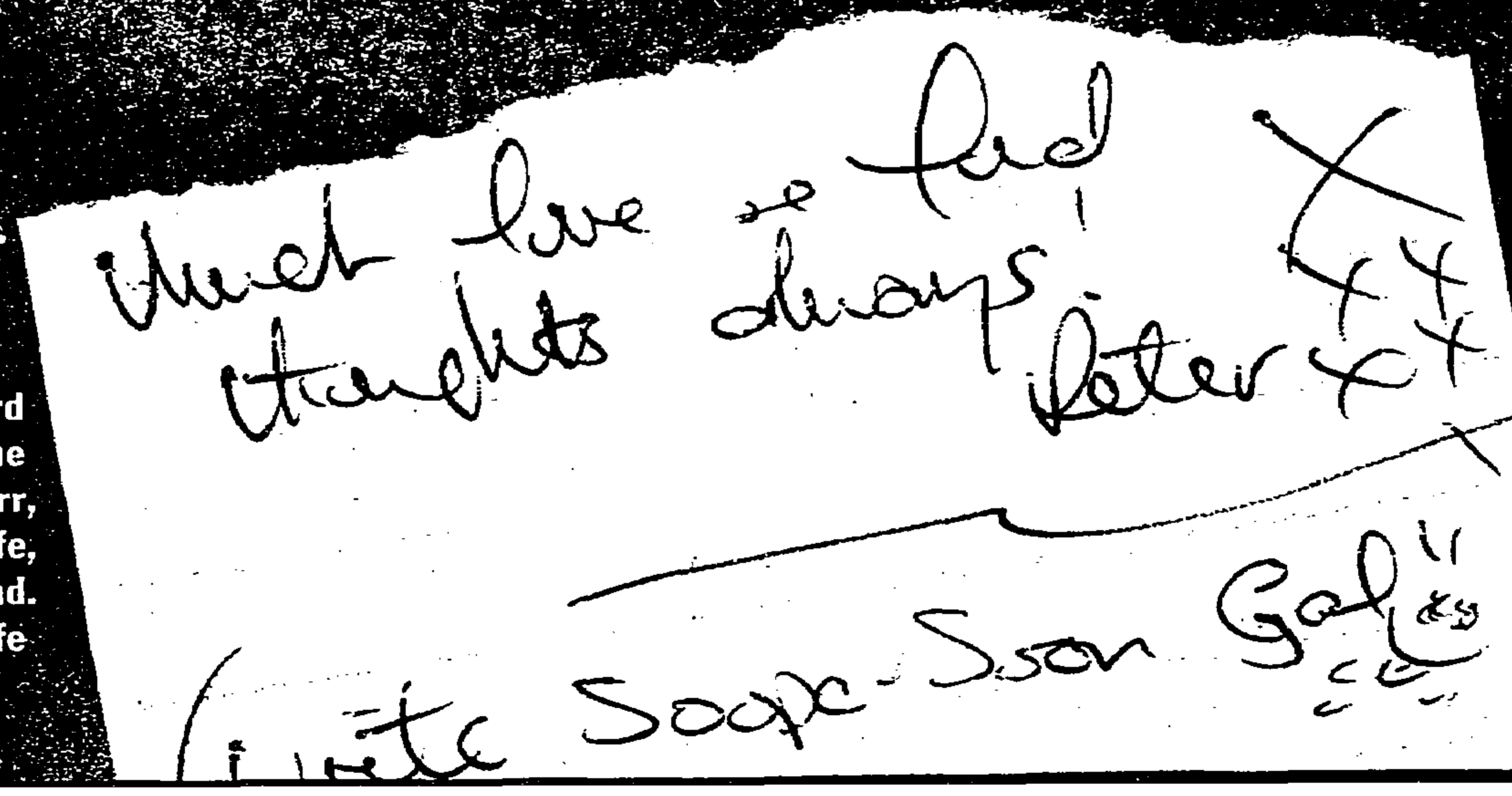


DEADLIER THAN THE MAIL
